AN INTRODUCTION TO PIVOT TABLES

Make your own Pivot Table with Google Sheets

Using the sample data available at this link: <u>TravelPac Q1 2019</u> - have a go at creating pivot tables to answer the questions below.

- 1. Open a new Google Sheet
- 2. Click on File Import then select the downloaded file "TravelPac Q1 2019.xls" and create new sheet.
- 3. Open the second tab labelled '2019 Q1'
- 4. Select all the data (Ctrl+ a, or select all) so that all the data you wish to analyse is highlighted
- 5. On the Menu bar, select Data Pivot Table new sheet this will then show you the Pivot Table Editor
- 6. In the Pivot Table Editor next to Rows click add and choose 'Sex'
- 7. In the Pivot Table Editor next to Columns click add and choose 'Purpose'
- 8. To add a new thing to count, In the Pivot Table Editor next to **Values** click add and in this case choose 'Sex'
- 9. The table will now populate with numbers, showing you the answer to the first question.
- 10. Repeat with different variables. Don't forget there's also an option to add filters.

Questions with answers

1. How many women travelled for business?

Answer: 3

2. What is the most common purpose of travel?

Answer: VFR - visiting friends or relatives

3. Which age group most travelled as part of an inclusive tour package?

Answer: 45-54

4. What is the most common duration for visitors from the USA?

Answer: 1-3 nights (requires filter by ukos overseas and country USA)

5. What is the preferred mode of travel for UK residents?

Answer: Air

6. Do German or French visitors spend more?

Answer: German (requires filter by ukos overseas only)

7. How many young men (under 24 years old) travelled independently? 3

Answer: 37(16-24) + 74(0-15) = 411

8. Do UK business travellers prefer to travel by air or rail?

Answer: Air
