## **Answers**

- 1) Marie Therese says coursebooks work because they set out a syllabus and a curriculum, and they can advise teachers about what tenses to teach and what sort of vocabulary they can introduce at particular levels.
- 2) Lindsay says that if you work for a company that provides you with materials, you may be able to **adapt them depending on the company's policy**.
- **3)** Marie Therese says the internet is a good place for materials, for example, **YouTube videos**, **TED Talks**, **articles from newspapers**.
- 4) Lindsay talks about learners bringing materials to lessons. For example, you might have a business person who says they need to write a letter or they've received an email that they would like you to help them with.
- 5) Jade says it's important to keep tasks and handouts as simple as possible and to limit the number you use in a lesson.
- 6) Helen says teachers need to plan what learners do in the lesson, and to decide which activities should be done in lesson time and which activities should be individual study.
