
Develop your 1-minute EPIC message.

E Engage	ENGAGE YOUR AUDIENCE Get your listener's attention with a dramatic fact or short statement. Keep this opening statement to one sentence if possible.
P Problem	STATE THE PROBLEM Present causes of the problem you introduced in the first section. How widespread or serious is the problem?
 Inform	INFORM ON THE SOLUTION Inform the listener about a solution to the problem you just presented.
C Call to Action	CALL TO ACTION Once you've engaged your listener, presented the problem and told them about a solution, be specific about what you want them to do. This enables you to follow up to learn if they've taken this action. Present this action in the form of a 'yes or no' question.
